The ICR Development Team is committed to building a strong global alliance with civil society partners to help us make our case for self-representation and defend us against political opponents nationally and internationally. To join this alliance, we ask prospective partners to endorse and comply with the below Code of Conduct. Only persons and/or organisation who sign up to this Code are eligible to join our alliance.

Be on our side

Share our foundational values of openness, equality and diversity.

See this partnership as means for empowerment and mobilisation and help us to both grow our movement, and forge new alliances.

Always allow activists to connect with us directly by providing contact details with every item you publish, online and offline (in print etc).

Protect internally displaced people, refugees and people living in exile (and those they left behind) by respecting their rights, including their right to privacy.

Respect our neutrality

Help establish the ICR as a movement that, in the interest of our members' safety and security, is 'neutral on the outside, but political on the inside'.

Do not use the work of the ICR for political score settling. Not respecting the ICR's neutrality will make it harder to stand up for the very people we exist to serve.

Defend us publically against anyone who tries to undermine our neutrality.
